ALSOBROOKS VERSUS HOGAN ON WORKERS' ISSUES:

Angela Alsobrooks:

"Building an economy that works for all Marylanders requires a commitment to the people who make that economy work. I would proudly be a co-sponsor of the PRO Act, to ensure that we can strengthen workers rights to collective bargaining and make it harder for corporations to prevent workers from organizing."*

Larry Hogan:

Clashed with labor groups over budget cuts, pension reforms, and privatization efforts. Pushed for fiscal austerity, as Governor to limit the power of unions. Supported reforms to the state's pension system, hindering workers' long-term financial security.

Angela Alsobrooks:

Supports protecting and expanding benefits for public-sector employees, particularly in areas such as pensions, healthcare, and job security, and favors policies that ensure robust staffing in public service sectors like education, law enforcement, and healthcare. Would proudly co-sponsor the Public Service Freedom to Negotiate Act.

Larry Hogan:

Has shown great disdain for labor unions. Vetoed multiple collective bargaining measures — SB9, SB717/HB 904. Vetoed legislation requiring prevailing wage be paid on utility projects. Called teachers unions officials 'thugs' on Facebook.

Angela Alsobrooks:

Emphasizes the need to prioritize worker safety in all work sectors including construction, health care, public works, investigative services, and transportation.

Larry Hogan:

Petoed a job creation tax credit bill that required employers to pay prevailing wages and benefits — HB278. Failed to sign legislation allowing collective bargaining for library employees, employees at the Maryland School for the Deaf and for sheriff's office employees in Baltimore. Advocated for legislation to weaken collective bargaining for teachers and attempted to freeze state employee pay. Vetoed the COVID-19 Testing, Contact Tracing and Vaccination Act of 2021.

EVEN LARRY HOGAN BELIEVES ANGELA ALSOBROOKS IS A GREAT LEADER

In April 2022, at a press event, then Governor Hogan said, "I shouldn't say this, because I'll get in trouble, but my dad is a former county executive, and one of my best friends for many years was [county executive] Wayne Curry. And I'll say, I can't remember a better county executive than Angela Alsobrooks. Thank you so much for your leadership."
